**Description:**

Eligible US municipalities receive funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program that is administered by HUD (the US Department of Housing and Urban Development). In Pennsylvania, most communities receive this funding through the state's Department of Economic and Community Development (PA DCED).

In Mifflin County, there are five CDBG "entitlement" municipalities with populations over 4,000 that have been determined to be eligible to receive their own allocations of CDBG funding: the Borough of Lewistown and the townships of Armagh, Brown, Derry, and Granville. The county also receives CDBG funding for eligible projects located in the remaining boroughs and townships. The county will accept formal proposals for eligible CDBG projects from March 30 through May 22, 2026. (Each of the entitlement communities have their own municipal project proposal deadlines.)

**During the county's CDBG program workshop on April 14, Mifflin County residents can learn about the requirements of the CDBG program, what kind of information is required for the formal application, and how to complete a project proposal to submit to the commissioners for consideration.**
