## Megan's Law Registration Guide

The Mifflin County Correctional Facility is an approved Registration/Verification or Change CPIN site for sex offenders to comply with state requirements. If you need to appear for Registration/Verification or Change pursuant to your sentence requirements you can have these procedures completed, anytime, at Mifflin County Correctional Facility.

If you need to register for the first time you must bring the original paperwork that indicates the charge(s) you are being registered for.

If you were already registered elsewhere and come to Mifflin County Correctional Facility for verification or change, we may need to complete a new registration as we are a CPIN site. If you were originally registered at a CPIN site, we can complete verification or change using your State Identification Number. If our CPIN system does not recall your information using your State Identification Number, we will complete a new registration. If our computer system is down, we will complete a manual (written) registration/verification to ensure that the requirements are met.
