

RESOLUTION NO. 3 of 2026
MIFFLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

APPOINTING A SECTION 504 COMPLIANCE OFFICER
AND
ESTABLISHING A GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, Mifflin County, Pennsylvania, is a recipient of federal funds from numerous sources, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and

WHEREAS, Mifflin County is statutorily required to develop administrative procedures and regulations in accordance with 24 CFR Part 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations, as effectuated on July 11, 1988, to implement Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

WHEREAS, Mifflin County must designate a Section 504 Compliance Officer who will serve as the GRANTEE's designated representative for any and all complaints regarding 24 CFR Part 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations and adopt grievance procedures.

WHEREAS, the Mifflin County has begun public outreach and consultation with interested parties to solicit input and feedback regarding Mifflin County's compliance with administrative rules and regulations related to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Mifflin County as follows:

1. Director of Maintenance and/or their designee is hereby designated as Mifflin County's Section 504 Compliance Officer.
2. Mifflin County has adopted a grievance procedure for any and all complaints regarding accessibility to all Mifflin County owned facilities and programs.
