## COMMUNITY NOTICE LETTER

March 30, 2026

To: Mifflin County municipal officials

Re: Mifflin County's FFY 2026 CDBG Entitlement Program - Application Cycle Open

Mifflin County's Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce the opening of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2026 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program application cycle. This grant program, administered by the PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED), is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as enacted by Pennsylvania Act 179.

Attached to this letter is the FFY 2026 CDBG application schedule and a project summary form. Applicants for CDBG program funding must include information about project eligibility, project fundability, estimated project cost, and estimated project schedule.

Eligible project activities include broad areas of community infrastructure, housing rehabilitation, economic development, and public services. Specific efforts may include, but are not limited to, development or improvement of water, sewer, and stormwater systems, removal of architectural barriers to accessibility, public youth/senior center improvements, parks/recreation facilities improvement, and reconstruction of sidewalks and streets.

To be fundable, projects must result in a direct benefit to low- and moderate-income level residents, and/or elimination of slums and blight, and/or elimination of urgent threats to health and safety.

Five municipalities within the county with populations greater than 4,000 receive CDBG entitlement allocations. Act 179 requires the county to serve as the local administering agency for CDBG funds for all county municipalities with populations less than 4,000 (non-entitlement communities).

Based on FFY 2025 allocation amounts, it is estimated that the county will receive \$222,625 in FFY 2026 CDBG funding for non-entitlement communities. The county's five entitlement municipalities are expected to receive the following amounts: Armagh Township - \$93,071; Brown Township - \$94,079; Derry Township - \$127,309; Granville Township - \$99,620; and Lewistown Borough - \$141,962.

Mifflin County will hold a public hearing and CDBG project development workshop in the meeting room of the Mifflin County Courthouse Annex, 101 West Third Street, Lewistown, PA 17044. The hearing will begin at 4:30 PM on Tues., April 14, 2026. Applicants are strongly urged to attend.
