The Mifflin County Salary Board met on Thursday, July 16, 2026 at 10:30 a.m. In attendance were Commissioner Kevin Kodish, Commissioner Noah Wise, Treasurer Diane Griffith, Chief Clerk Cathy Romig, Chief Clerk in Training Charity Larson, and Solicitor Steve Snook. Chairman Robert Postal was absent.

Guests in attendance were Payroll Manager Makyla Groce, Human Relations/Assistant Chief Clerk Barbara Lepley, Warden Jason Kormanic, and Court Administrator Christine Stuck.

I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. by Chairman Robert Postal.

II. Approval of Minutes of June 18, 2026

A motion was made by Commissioner Wise to approve. The motion was seconded by Treasurer Griffith. The motion was unanimously approved.

III. New Business

1. Update the Tipstaff Job Description

Court Administrator Christine Stuck explained the change is just to make the job description match the Tipstaff's current duties. The only change is the deletion of one line.

Commissioner Wise made a motion to accept the update to the Tipstaff job description as presented. Treasurer Griffith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Request from Warden Kormanic to increase the MAT LPN to the same hourly rate as the other LPN'S – Current MAT LPN is \$25.23/hour and other LPN'S is \$26.05

Warden Kormanic explained the MAT LPN is doing the same duties as the other LPNs on staff and so requested she be paid the same hourly rate. The pay for this position is mostly paid by grant monies and the increase would only result in a difference of a little over \$1000.00. The position is part-time with no benefits.

Commissioner Wise made a motion to approve the increase as requested. Treasurer Griffith seconded the motion.

3. Request from Public Defender Curry for Retention Initiative Bonuses:

Commissioner Wise made a motion to accept the initiative bonuses as requested.
